FREE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION: The City of Great Falls' Public Works Department is partnering with Veolia North America to host a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event. This event is free to the public and will be held on Saturday, April 12 from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm at the corner of 1st St. South and 3rd Ave. South.

The purpose of this event is to ensure the safe and compliant management and disposal of household chemicals and hazardous waste for the residents of Great Falls. Examples of acceptable waste at this event are antifreeze, gasoline, lighter fluid, paint thinner, road flares, shellac, fertilizer, pesticides, furniture polish, insect spray, disinfectants, hair color remover, nail polish, and more. Latex based paint products, mercury products, and waste from commercial businesses will not be accepted at this event.
